



## TEMPORARY JOB POSTING

Chacachas Treaty Nation is looking for individuals for Field Monitors to assist RPS during the Whitewood 3D Seismic Program.

These positions would be of a temporary nature from Approximately Jan 3 to March 31, 2025

In summary, the responsibilities of the Field Monitor include:

- Attending job orientation at project start-up
- Attending morning crew safety meetings each morning.
- Monitoring and overseeing seismic operations on Indigenous lands.
- Identify and mitigate any culturally sensitive areas.
- Identify and mitigate any environmentally sensitive areas.
- Ensuring compliance with land use agreements and permits.
- Community liaison to landowners and renters on Indigenous lands.
- Ensuring safety protocols are followed.
- Coordinating with the field supervisor and other stakeholders.
- Hours of work: Begin with 7am safety meetings – day rates based on a 12 hour days which includes travel.

As for requirements, it is generally expected that the worker should have:

- Minimum safety Tickets required would be:
  - Standard First Aid
  - WHMIS (required for working with fuel/UTV)
- A valid driver's license and reliable transportation.
- Completion of an orientation meeting and training specific to the role.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- Knowledge of land use agreements and permits.
- Due to this being a safety sensitive position, a mandatory clean drug and alcohol test is required within 90 days of starting date.
