

## **TEMPORARY JOB POSTING**

Chacachas Treaty Nation is looking for individuals to assist RPS with Spring Cleanup Operations after the Whitewood 3D Seismic Program.

These positions would be of a temporary nature from Approximately May 1 to June 10, 2025

For the person responsible for spring clean-up after seismic operations, their tasks include:

- Traveling and cleaning up all lines (on UTV) to find any gear, refuse, supplies that may have been dropped during operations.
- Inspect all shot holes to ensure they plugged in accordance with seismic regulations.
- Removing any debris or equipment left behind this includes pulling leads from dynamite holes.
- Ensuring that the area is left in a safe and environmentally responsible condition.
- · Reporting any issues or concerns to the field supervisor.
- Hours of work: Begin with 7am safety meetings day rates based on 12-hour days which
  includes travel.

As for requirements, it is generally expected that the worker should have:

- Minimum safety Tickets required would be:
  - Standard First Aid
  - WHMIS (required for working with fuel/UTV)
  - UTV course
- A valid driver's license and reliable transportation.
- UTV for spring clean-up would be helpful and compensated for
- Completion of an orientation meeting and training specific to the role.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- Knowledge of land use agreements and permits.
- Due to this being a safety sensitive position, a mandatory clean drug and alcohol test is required within 90 days of starting date
